July 7th, 1896 - at Springfield College the first game of "Volleyball" was played.



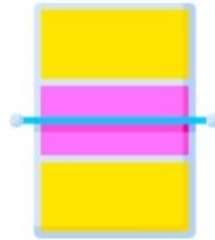

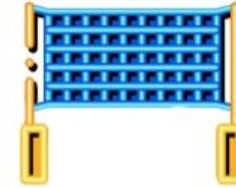

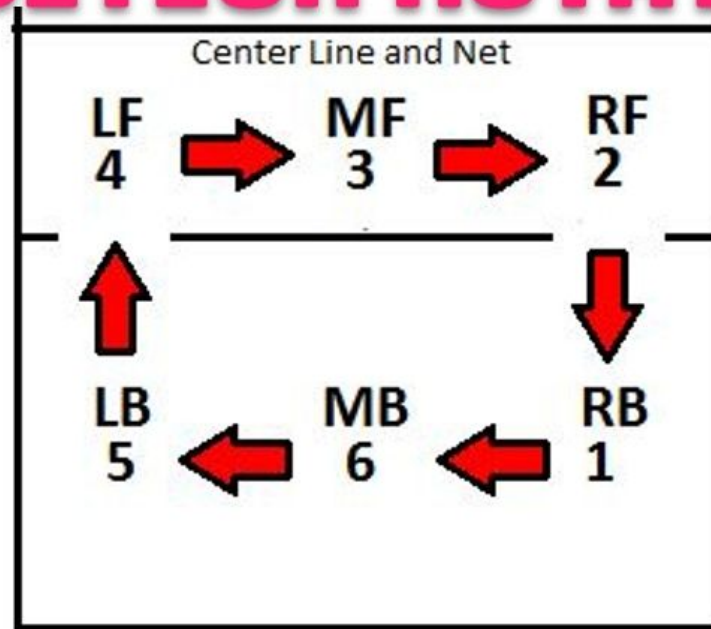
POSITIONS
